Shoppers will find vintage and antique furniture, jewelry, clothing and home and garden decor as well as upcycled items and artisanal foodstuffs and sundries. Junk Bonanza visitors value it as a reliable resource for design inspiration and future trends in home decor, thanks to its creative and inventive vendors.

Paying homage to the vintage vibe, the Bonanza has assembled an expert group of six “Old School” artisans who will offer free ongoing and hands-on demonstrations of their twists on traditional crafts — freehand silhouette portraiture, machine chainstitch embroidery, tintype photography, yarnbombing, string art and wreathmaking.

The Bonanza is pleased to welcome Lauren Muney, one of about 20 artisans worldwide skilled in the master art of freehand-scissored silhouette portraiture. Attendees may reserve a time slot at the show to have their portraits cut to take home, free of charge. Information about Muney’s appearance and those of the other five artisans — Benjamin Kelly of Dinosaur Hampton, Carla Rodriguez of Blkk Hand, Quinn Berger of Knitteapolis, Katharine Leary of On Lilac Lane and Christine Hoffman of Foxglove — are detailed on a separate release in this packet.
